## 2016-2017 SCHOOL CALENDAR

This calendar reflects 184 school days, having 4 snow days built in. School will close for students at the end of the 180<sup>th</sup> actual day of school.

If no snow days are used, school will end for students and staff on June 16.

If one snow day is used, school will end for students on June 19 and staff on June 20.

If two snow days are used, school will end for students on June 20 and for staff on June 21.

If three snow days are used, school will end for students on June 21 and for staff on June 22.

If four snow days are used, school will end for students on June 22 and staff on June 23.

**If five or more snow days are used, days will be taken from Spring Recess starting with Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>. Therefore, school will still end for students on June 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

**Staff attendance will be mandatory if we need to use any days during our Spring Recess. With this advance notice, it would be advisable to make plans that can be altered without financial cost to you.**

### **Pupil Assistance Committees**

A Pupil Assistance Committee (PAC) is available in every school to assess students who have social, emotional or educational needs. Students thought to be in need of these services may be referred to PAC. Referrals to PAC are initiated by contacting the building principal, guidance counselor, teacher, or the office of Special Education.

### **Referral for Special Education Services**

A parent or guardian of a child in the district may request a referral to the Child Study Team by contacting the building principal or by writing to the Director of Special Services.
