

Dear L-H Families:

I hope this email finds you well and ready for the long weekend. Inasmuch as we have had an outstanding response to our protocols - observations are being made that require your immediate attention and resolution as applicable - please also communicate with your caregivers.

1. **Masks MUST be worn while on school property** (this applies to students, staff and caregivers).

2. School property consists of any land on the inside of the sidewalks along Woodland, Crescent and Sherman avenues - to the building. The blacktop and fields behind the school are school property.

3. There is no use of the playground during school hours - 8:00-3:00 (this includes at 12:30 dismissal, as this is the time in which students are expected to go home, have lunch and prepare for remote instruction will starts this Tuesday, 9/8/2020 daily from 1:30-3:00)

Ultimately, it is incumbent on our entire L-H community (staff, students , parents and caregivers) to follow the rules and protocols that are designed to keep us safe, so we can get on with the business of learning. I appreciate your attention to this matter, communication with any caregivers and understanding that in the event there is not a resolution on the part of some individuals - I will be addressing these families directly, in tandem with communicating to the Board Office.
