Unfortunately, I am sending this communication out to you with a notification for those families/babysitters who are using the staff parking lot for pick up or as a U-turn opportunity. I received notification today regarding issues with the staff lot:

**A new trend - parents and babysitters are using the parking lot as a u turn.**

**Today, a black Acadia - who appears to be breaching the staff parking lot repeatedly, was observed almost hitting a teacher's car as they were trying to back out because she flew around the curve close to the building.**

**Some students are walking directly through the parking lot (being accompanied by parents and babysitters) and not using the sidewalks.**

Please be advised that I will be reporting out incidents to the Summit Police Department directly from here on out - with license plate information. As this is truly a simple matter of compliance with the posted signs and multiple communications, as well as following the rules, and most importantly - ensuring the safety of our students, staff and other parents - I have no other recourse.
